Research in general populations consistently tells us that sexual abuse is a relatively common type of harm, affecting around 24% of people in childhood (NSPCC 2011). Its impact on child and adult well-being can be pervasive and enduring. Despite its prevalence, sexual abuse is under-reported, under-represented in child protection populations, and there are significant barriers to children disclosing it to professionals. Kingston and Richmond LSCB has highlighted Child Sexual Abuse as a focus of its work, we encourage you to save this date as an opportunity to learn together.
