Pre-birth Assessments and Teenage Parents	This one day course aims to enable participants to undertake effective and timely pre-birth assessments in partnership with parents.	19 June 2017 09:30-16:30
Drugs and Alcohol Awareness	This half day course aims to engage with the topic of substance use raising awareness of the effects drugs and alcohol can have on your mind and body, providing delegates with an awareness of the key issues on drug and alcohol misuse.	22 June 2017 13:00-15:00
