What training does Kingston and Richmond Local Safeguarding Children Board (LSCB) offer?

Kingston and Richmond Local Safeguarding Children Board (LSCB) Training Programme provides courses, briefings and workshops with a focus on multi-agency training which complements training already available within individual agencies. It not only covers child protection issues but deals with the broad area of safeguarding.

The Benefits of multi-agency training

It is an opportunity to learn about the roles and responsibilities of colleagues in other agencies and to consider how we can work together to keep children safe. Furthermore, Serious Case Reviews highlight how the ability of professionals from different backgrounds to work together and communicate effectively can have a crucial impact on children's safety and well being.

Who can attend training?

The LSCB training programme is available to all professionals and volunteers working with children and young people in Kingston and Richmond.

Confirmation of a place, the date, time and venue will be sent via joining instructions to the participant by the LSCB Training Administrator.

Participants must only attend where confirmation has been received.

Who facilitates training?

The training courses are facilitated by a variety of individual trainers, some are employed by the various partner agencies within the LSCB and others are independent and private training organisations.

Training Charges

Places on multi-agency training courses are generally available at no additional cost to agencies and sectors, which have contributed to the Kingston and Richmond LSCB budget. Places for the voluntary and third sector are provided fully funded; for schools and agencies who do not work with children and young people in Kingston and Richmond, training charges are as follows:

Full day training session - £120

LSCB Safeguarding Children: A Shared Responsibility (Level 2) - £80

Half day training session - £60

Cancellations

If you wish to cancel your training place or are unable to attend due to illness / emergency situation, you must cancel as soon as possible. If the cancellation is last minute please call 020 8487 5125.

Kingston and Richmond LSCB has agreed that the full cost of a training place will be charged as a cancellation fee to all agencies where a participant does not attend a course on which they are booked, and where 5 working days' notice to the LSCB Team was not given.
